**Frequently Asked Questions**

**Q: Do I have to be a member of California Coast Credit Union to apply for the Educator Grant?**

A: No, membership in California Coast Credit Union is encouraged, but not required to apply.

**Q: Is there a fee to apply for the Educator Grant?**

A: No, the application process does not require a fee.

**Q: What type of documentation is required to verify that I am teaching in K-12, public and private schools, community or state college in San Diego or South Riverside Counties?**

A: School I.D. card and references from the school.

**Q: Can I apply for multiple Educator Grants annually?**

A: One application per educator, per year. If your application is unsuccessful, you may reapply the following year.

**Q: Are support activities or projects outside the STREAM subject categories eligible for the grant?**

A: No, the Educator Grant will not fund activities or projects that are not STREAM focused.

**Q: Would an improvement on an existing STREAM related project be eligible to apply?**

A: Possibly if the improvement met the eligibility requirements as noted in the criteria of the grant.

**Q: When will applicants be notified?**

A: Approximately late August.

**Q: If I receive funding in December, when can I reapply?**

A: We ask that grant recipients reapply after one year from receipt of grant funds. Grant cycles typically begin in the first quarter of the calendar year.
