Impacted federal employees who are not yet members of Cal Coast may also be eligible for assistance.

- Cal Coast is offering a 0% APR 90-day personal loan for the amount of the member’s last net payroll up to \$5,000.
- Or members may choose a 90-day loan payment deferral for existing Cal Coast loans.

For those who are not yet a Cal Coast member, a membership may be established to be considered for assistance.
