**California Coast Credit Union Sets Up Fund
to Help Members Impacted by SoCal Wildfires**

SAN DIEGO – December 22, 2017 – California Coast Credit Union has established a Fire Relief Fund to help members impacted by the Lilac, Liberty and Thomas Wildfires in Southern California.

Cal Coast President & CEO Todd Lane said, “Our thoughts are with everyone who is affected by these devastating wildfires. We recently learned that some of our members have lost homes to the Lilac Wildfire and it is possible other members may be impacted by the Liberty and Thomas Wildfires. Our members are truly like family to us and we have established this Fire Relief Fund to help them recover and start rebuilding their lives.”

The Fire Relief Fund will provide a \$1,000 donation to each eligible member whose primary residence has been destroyed by the Lilac, Liberty or Thomas Wildfire. Eligible members may receive additional financial help including delaying or reducing loan payments for existing loans, priority loan processing and credit line increases, penalty-free early withdrawals from Certificate Accounts, free replacement checks and ATM, credit and check cards.
