

2023 Cal Coast Cares Foundation – High School Student Scholarship Criteria

The Cal Coast Cares Foundation is pleased to announce a scholarship award program to support college-bound high school seniors residing in San Diego or Riverside County. The scholarship program is in honor of James L. McPheters, who retired after 21 years as President & CEO of California Coast Credit Union.

- 1. To be eligible, a graduating high school senior must:
 - Be a member of California Coast Credit Union, or the child, grandchild or legal ward of a member in good standing.
 - Reside in San Diego or Riverside County.
 - Have a weighted cumulative high school grade point average (GPA), or equivalent, of at least 3.0 on a scale of 0 4.0. An official transcript is required.
 - Have applied or been accepted to attend an accredited college or university and enroll in a minimum of 12 units.
- 2. Each scholarship will be awarded no later than December 31, 2023.
- 3. The award will be determined by the Scholarship Selection Committee appointed by the Cal Coast Cares Foundation Board.
- 4. With the permission of the award recipient and parent/guardian, the recipient's name and photograph may be included in public relations efforts. Note: parent/guardian's permission is not required to apply for the scholarship.
- 5. The Scholarship Selection Committee will rely on information provided from the student's current school during the selection process.
- Credit union staff, officials and their families are not eligible to participate in the scholarship program.
- 7. Applications should be completed and submitted online via DocuSign (including all attachments) no later than **April 30, 2023.** Incomplete applications will not be reviewed.
